





1. To form the projects and to run following schemes:

- a) The Educational facilities are not available in the tribal area and hence with a view to give the facility of Education to the Backward Classes, Scheduled Tribe and Castes and Nomadic Tribes, the educational higher technical institutions right from Montessori to college are to be established for such backward persons and to run Lodging and Boarding for the students. To give aid to the needy students in respect of study books and educational instruments, and medicines. To promote the national games, training in games and exercises, formation of exercise room etc. Research and production of surgical cotton and instruments for the hospital.
 - b) To give training and technical education to the educated unemployed youths, untrained labourers for increasing their capability and for getting better jobs. To explain and give guidance to the needy unemployed in respect of various schemes of government for getting benefits of the same.
 - c) To undertake scheme and plans for promoting the business of milk and getting of milk. Cattle for getting more and good quality of milk. To open the shop-centers for supply of cattle food.
 - d) To promote and undertake Adult education schemes in rural and hilly areas and to implement the schemes of various education, and schemes for promoting National Integrity and to undertake programmes for promoting brotherly relations among all castes of people.
3. To establish Hospitals in Rural areas. To arrange medical camps for diagnosis of various diseases and to give medical aid through expert doctors.
4. To establish special work shops for the blind and disabled physically handicapped person and also to establish centers for making artificial parts for the disabled To secure financial assistance from Govt. Semi

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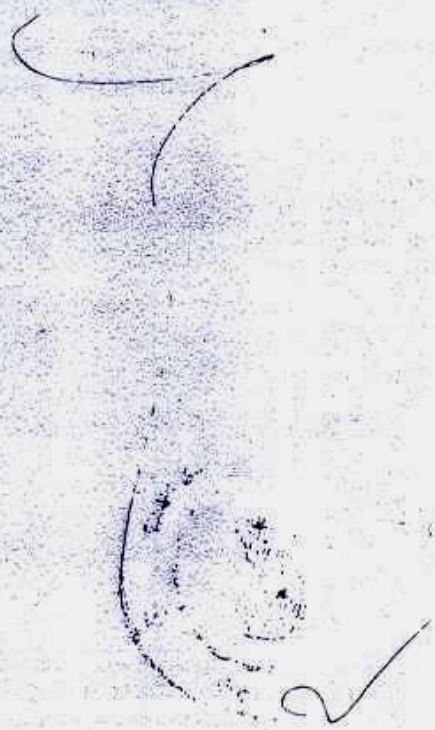
- Govt. and other institutions for giving employment to such blind and disabled and physically handicapped persons
- 5. To provide health education to all, irrespective of caste, creed, religion or race and take special care of elderly persons, through interaction and education about health awareness, nutritional education, home crafts, literacy, cleanliness, avoidance of tobacco and alcohol etc. Any other activity of social uplift of rural Adivasi and hilly people.
- 6. To establish Old Age Homes, Day Care Center, Mobile Medical Unit and other facility for elderly and poor persons and to make arrangements for their medical treatment.
- 7. To run different activities for farmers and help them for their development. To establish cold storage, mineral water, food processing training institute etc.
- 8. To conduct research in the field of animal health and provide education by starting a veterinary educational institution.
- 9. To organise various cultural programs in order to develop a feeling of national integration. To provide youth with sports, cultural, library and educational facilities.
- 10. To instill a sense of national and cultural integration among the youths through celebration of birth and death anniversaries of national leaders.
- 11. To instill a sense of educational, cultural and national integration among the citizens.
- 12. To implement the rural development programs, both government and semi-government especially related to water availability and storage.
- 13. To encourage the youth to keep themselves away from criminal offences, addiction, and enter in to rendering of social services to our people.
- 14. To conduct research in the field of medicine and health and provide education in the field of homeopathy, ayurveda and allopathic medicine.

- 15. To establish Shishu Grih for orphan children and give them shelter, education and rehabilitations.
- 16. To establish Krishi Vigyan Udyog Kendra. To give guidelines for improvement of Crops and Agriculture.
- 17. To organize conferences, seminars and training camps on social, economic, cultural and welfare subjects in order to bring awareness and progress in society.
- 18. To make such programs for educated women and girls through which they could be skilled and get economic self reliance and improve their quality of life. To assist in formation of self help groups.
- 19. To implement projects in the field of solar and wind energy and other alternate sources of energy.
- 20. To assist and arrange relief works in natural disasters like flood, earthquake, droughts etc.
- 21. To make audio video albums, telefilms, for training and documentaries for generating self employments in the field of art, culture and entertainment. To publish newsletters, magazines, newspapers for bringing the developments in the field of education, health and sanitation, agriculture, economics and politics.

c) The membership of the member, whose conduct is found to be immoral or whose activities are found against the interest of the institution or harmful to the institution, the managing committee shall have the right to cancel the membership of such member but the decision will have to be taken in the special meeting called for the said purpose.

3. Constitution of the managing committee and office bearer:

The managing committee shall consist of five members only as under:

- a) Chairman
- b) Secretary
- c) Treasurer
- d) Member
- e) Member

- I. The members of the managing committee shall be elected by the members of the institution.
- II. The members of the institution shall have a right to elect the members of the managing committee by voting through ballot Or any way of election.
- III. The members elected on managing committee shall have a right to elect from among themselves the office bearers as mentioned above.
- IV. Member shall cease to be a member on death, mental and physical disability and legal conviction.

4. Duration of Managing committee:

The duration of managing committee shall be five years from the date of election

5. Duties and function of the managing committee:

- a) The managing committee shall meet at least four times in a year. A quorum of at least three persons shall be essential for a meeting under this regulations.
- b) The managing committee is empowered to make appointments of the employees as per requirement. The managing committee is also empowered to take disciplinary action against any employee for the misconduct. The managing committee is also empowered to dismiss any employee for severe misconduct. The managing committee has to keep watch and control over the employee staff for the smooth working and administration of the institution.
- c) To watch and keep control over the branch offices of the institution.
